Limb Valley & Burbage Mines Sunday 22nd September

Limb Valley is an area of woodland with a mix of mature conifer plantation, open mixed woodland and a small area of garden around Whirlow Hall. There is an often steep sided stream valley running though it. The seasonal undergrowth is limited in the deciduous woodland areas. The brown course will be more challenging as it passes out of the Limb valley and extends to Burbage mines which is full of complex contour detail, but unfortunately has some dead running to reach this better part of the maps.

Access: Car parking will be Whirlow Hall Farm, Whirlow Lane Sheffield (SE 313832 Postcode S11 9QF). The event will be signposted from the A625 Ecclesall Road South at the Junction with the B6068 Abbey Lane.

The nearest train station is at Dore.

Courses: White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown And String.

Please note that the Brown course is slightly longer than normal to take advantage of the Burgbage Mines terrain. All other courses are within the Limb Valley. The string course is within Whirlow Hall Farm.
